

**Saturday 14th June 2025 – Woodland Light in oil or acrylic
with David “DJ” Johnson
1.30 – 4.30pm**



In this workshop we will look at different ways to paint trees, branches and foliage and how colour and tonal values can help to bring your trees to life. We'll explore a variety of ways to apply paint using brushes, sponges, palette knives and canvas wedges to help recreate the marks and textures found in trees and to play with the beautiful Woodland Light. To increase the textural element you will have a go at adding sand to your paint! Suitable for all abilities.

Materials list -

- A selection of brushes and Palette Knives
- Canvas or similar painting surface approx 14" x 18" or 16" x 20"
- A selection of paints (oil or acrylics) to include: titanium white, yellow ochre, burnt sienna, cadmium yellow (or similar), alizarin crimson, raw umber, cerulean blue, ultramarine blue, purple

Table easels and water pots are available to borrow at CCS.

If you will be working in oils please bring along some low odour turps or similar.

*Please note, that painting that you do on the day may not be the one we have used to advertise this date but will be of the same style and medium / technique.
