Watercolour Paints x 8 :

Ultramarine Blue / Cerulean Blue / Burnt Sienna / Yellow Ochre / Cadmium Red / Cadmium Yellow / Alizarin Crimson / Neutral Tint (or Paynes Grey)

Brushes: (must be watercolour brushes) x 4:

1 x large Round (size 12 or 14) / 1 x Small Round (size 5 or 6) / 1 x half inch Flat / 1 x size 3 Rigger

Other Items: Paper (any size up to A4 or ¼ Imperial) / Flat water Tub (plastic butter tub) / Palette (small white plate) / Kitchen Tissue paper / 3b Pencil and Eraser / A board to tape your paper to / masking tape / Plus any personal favourite items.
