You will also be looking at how to achieve the beautiful Autumnal colours including tips for colour mixing.

Materials list -

- Stretched canvas (14" x 18" or 16" x 20")
- Palette
- A selection of brushes including a rigger, bristle brushes (filbert and flat) and any old brushes where the bristles have started to spread out.
- Palette knives (trowel and chisel shape)
- Acrylic Paints in : Titanium White, Yellow Ochre, Cadmium yellow, Cadmium red, Burnt Sienna, Raw Umber, Cerulean Blue, Ultramarine Blue and purple (Suggested colours, but similar is absolutely fine)
