Bold & Beautiful Florals in Watercolour with Nicky Hunter



Paint flowers in loose and lively watercolour with watercolour artist and popular tutor Nicky Hunter, well known for capturing blooms in a bold and beautiful way.

Nicky will guide you through the stages of a painting using wet into wet and direct painting methods to help you integrate the background, the foliage and the flowers effectively, allowing the painting although bold and radiant, to also have harmony and depth. Nicky helps students understand how to use watercolour medium effectively to get better results and gain more joy using this challenging yet magical medium, so your artworks sing from the page.

This workshop is suitable for those who have some experience of working with watercolour.

Materials list:

- Pencil, rubber, water pot, kitchen roll
- Board to tape paper onto and masking tape
- Watercolour paper - Rough texture 300 grams weight, good quality such as Saunders Waterford or similar (cotton rag quality is best)
- Brushes - large and medium squirrel mops or similar, Escoda size 10 synthetic or similar pointed round synthetic brush
- Tube watercolour paints (preferable to pans) to include: Permanent rose, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, Raw Sienna, Windsor Red or other primary red such as transparent Pyrrole, Lemon Yellow (Hue not Cadmium) or similar bright yellow such as transparent Hansa or Aureolin
