



"Wild Water" in acrylics with Colin Davies
Saturday 3rd October

This one-day course is full of useful tips and simple techniques for using paint to portray the power and beauty of ocean waves crashing onto a rocky shoreline. You will acquire an understanding of compositional basics and colour mixing, as well as being shown techniques to apply texture as an important component for creating the illusion of depth and complexity in the painting. Encouraged to paint with bold swathes of dramatic colour, you will learn how to use vigorous mark making with palette knives and brushes to create a dynamic painting that depicts a sense of movement, energy and drama.

Please bring along:

Acrylic paints: Paynes Grey; Vandyke Brown; Prussian Blue; Ultramarine Blue; Cobalt Blue; Viridian Green, Alizarine Red; Magenta, Yellow Ochre & Titanium White. (or any colours similar to those listed)

50cm x 50cm canvas or board
