

Saturday 30th January - Painting & Drawing by Erasing
with Scott Euden



One day workshop focusing on developing atmospheric landscape imagery, using a dynamic process of applying and removing mixed media.

This workshop will involve processes of creating effective marks by working into, erasing and rubbing into the canvas. An informal and varied approach to mark making that will produce atmospheric scenes of our natural/rural landscape. Everyone will learn engaging approaches to creativity that focus on the process and letting the outcome 'arrive', by using different mark making tools and mixed media.

This will be an explorative workshop focusing on the value of the creative process rather than fixating on the finished result – come with an open mind and get lost in your creativity. Suitable for all abilities.
