Celebrate the rich colours and atmosphere of the season in Painting Autumn Landscapes with Watercolour, a relaxing one-day workshop for all skill levels. Explore techniques for capturing glowing foliage, autumnal trees and changing light using transparent watercolour washes and expressive brushwork. Guided by Jonathan, participants will learn about colour mixing, composition, and creating depth and mood in landscape painting. The workshop offers a supportive and inspiring environment to develop confidence, creativity, and personal style.

By the end of the day you will have completed a couple of small paintings.

Please bring along:

1 x A4 or ¼ imperial pad of 'Not' surface watercolour paper 140lb/300gsm ('Not' refers to the surface texture of the paper and is also known as CP (cold pressed) or Bockingford)

1 x size 8 or 10 round watercolour brush

1 x size 2 or 4 round watercolour brush

Watercolour paint, either tubes or pans. If bringing tubes then you will need a palette to mix paint on. I recommend the following colours: Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue (optional), Cadmium Yellow Pale, Burnt Sienna, Raw Sienna or Yellow Ochre, Alizarin Crimson or Cadmium Red

2B pencil, Pencil sharpener, Eraser

Tissues, Water container

Jonathan will have a selection of tools and materials to buy on the day but may not have enough for everyone.
